## Christmas Service Instructions

### Christmas Eve

This is a candlelight service you can use by yourself or with family and friends to help you focus on Christ this Christmas. It is not meant to be a reason not to go to your church's service but to be used as well as, or if you don't have a service to go to

### Christmas Day

This is a service that can be done any time Christmas day. You can do it before you open the presents or with your family at dinner time. It can be done with or without candles; the choice is yours

### Supplies needed for Christmas Eve only

- ❖ Your Advent wreath with all but the Christ candle lit
- ❖ A candle for each person probably taper candles but they don't have to be
- ❖ Foil cut into squares about 4 inches across stand the candle in the center, fold the foil up around the candle then fold the corners down part way so the foil will protect people's hands from the drippings wax.
- ❖ I also recommend a fire extinguisher close at hand just in case.

### Supplies needed for both services

- ❖ A copy of the service for each person
- ❖ If you are like me and the good Lord has given you a number of talents none of which include music you can check out this web site they will play for you so you can sing along. Sing along Christmas carols [www.the-north-pole.com](http://www.the-north-pole.com). They have all but the first two songs.

### Suggestions for both services

If you are doing this by yourself of course you get to do all the parts but if you are doing it with family and/or friends you can divide it up in advance maybe one person as the "Narrator" (bold print) and the others dividing up the scriptures. Of course everyone gets to sing. The lines that are in brackets are instructions they are not to be read.

## Christmas Eve Candlelight Service Redeemer foretold

It's Christmas Eve and the bustle of shopping is over. The presents are wrapped, The Advent wreath is lit everything is ready. The wait is almost over. We have been preparing for the coming of the Messiah for the last month, but at the time of Christ's birth the people of Israel had been waiting hundreds of years almost since the beginning of the world, for the King of Kings who would bring peace, freedom and Life, The one who would break the curse put on all people because of their fall from grace when they chose to do what they wanted instead of listening to God.
